Condition: The operator of the vehicle may complain of dead batteries, hard or slow

cranking, a failure to start or premature alternator failure.

Cause: A potential cause for the above conditions is excessive parasitic

(quiescent draw) from aftermarket accessories, OnStar® system calibration files, factory installed XM radio module flaws or the operator rapidly turning the ignition on and off which may result in the electronic

control module not sending a "sleep" signal.

Correction: Procedures detailing quiescent draw testing are available in *TSB-006*

Measuring Quiescent Draw. Follow the manufacturer's recommended procedures for performing the diagnostics on each module as there are different flaws that may be causing the excessive draw. OE Bulletin 09-06-03-003 includes details as to when parts like the XM radio module requires replacing, when the OnStar® module or Engine Control Modules require

calibration or replacement.
